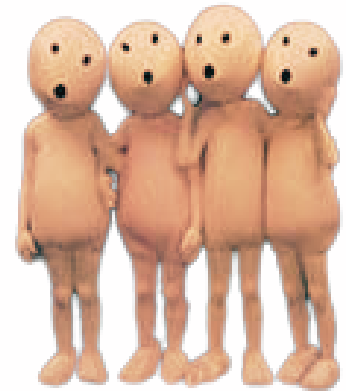

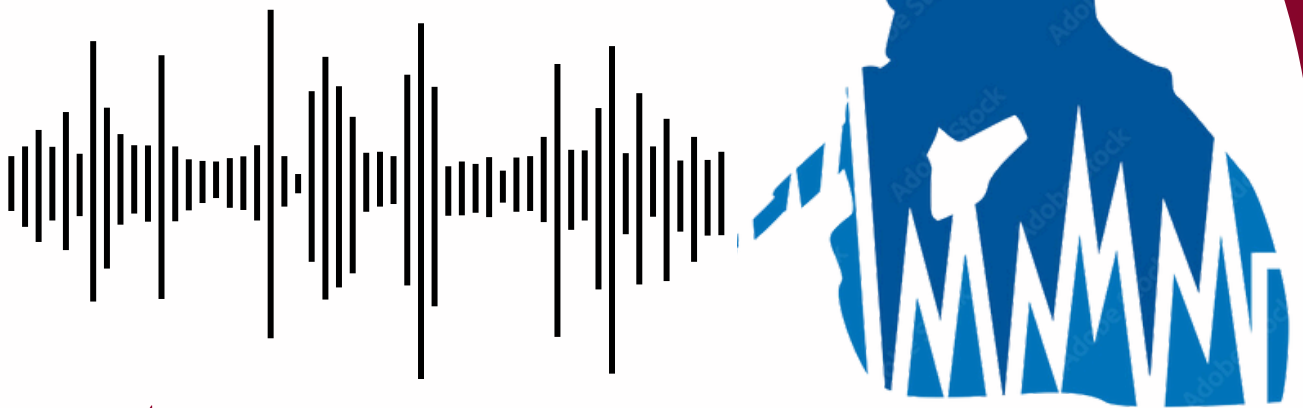

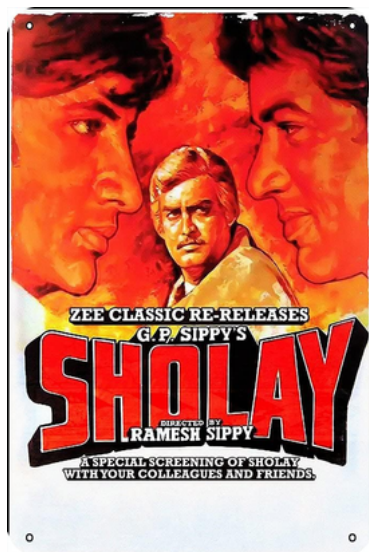

- The decision of the judge's will be final and binding.

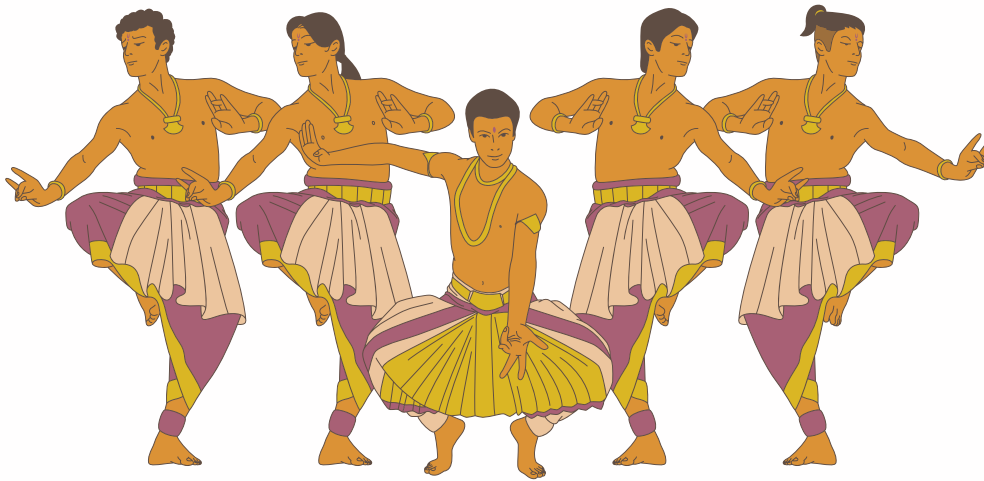

## Theme:

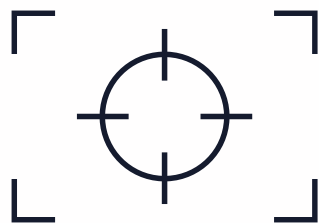

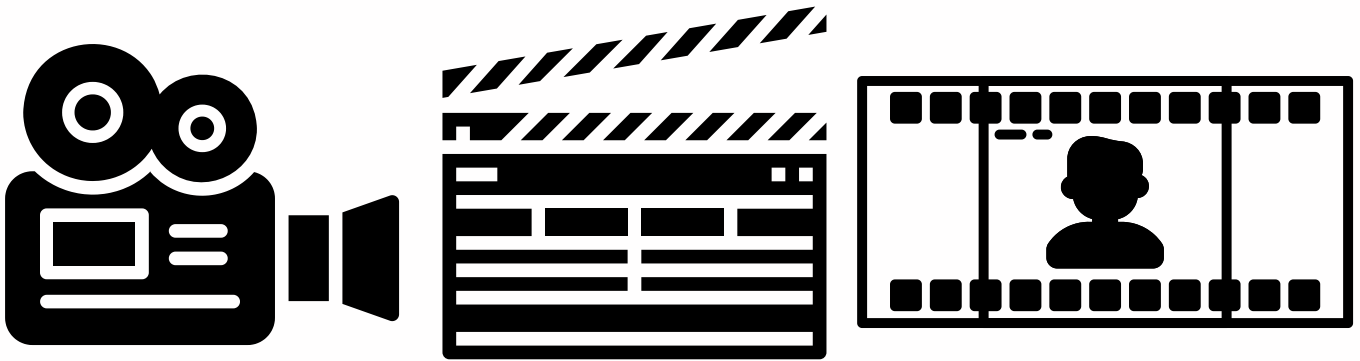
